

Thursday, February 5, 1671: Notification of the intended marriage of Theodoor Kerckrinck and Clara Maria van den Enden in the *Puyboeck* of the City of Amsterdam.

Compareerden [...] Dirck Kerckeringh van A'dam, medecynen doctor, oud 32 jaren, ouders doot, geass. met syn muy Petronella Kerckring, woont op de Keizersgracht, en Clara Maria van den Enden van Antwerpen, oud 27 jaren, geass. met Dr. Franciscus van den Ende, wonende op de Cingel.
